Things to know (or remember):

- CLOSE CONTACTS are those who have been within 6 feet of a confirmed positive classmate or staff member, for 15 or more minutes.
- If your child is tested for COVID, please let us know as soon as possible. If your child is positive, we must begin contact tracing to determine those considered close contacts. Your child may not return to school if they have pending test results.
- When a child tests positive, only those close contacts will be called. The rest of the class will be notified by an email.
- Please be sure to read the most recent Superintendent's Update regarding updated quarantine protocols.
- Appropriate wearing of masks is of increased importance as it is the key to fewer students and staff being excluded due to quarantine as well as decreased potential of contracting COVID.
